NEW BUSINESS ITEMS

1. 2021 Base Room Rental Prices / 2021 Guest Price List for Equipment and Services: Bill Zeinemann, Associate Director - Marketing and Event Services

A motion was made by O'Connor, seconded by Ring, to approve the 2021 Base Room Rental Prices and 2021 Guest Price List for Equipment and Services. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

2. 2019 Year-End Results / 2020 Financials and Forecast: Jeff Boyd, Business Manager

Pre-audit, the 2019 year ended with a revenue surplus of \$24,000. This does not include the \$200,000 in reserves that was added to the budget, but not used. Some of this \$224,000 may need to be applied to expenses the city has yet to enter and back date for 2019.

2020 will be a challenging year due to several expense items that cannot be budgeted; five retirements and the hourly benefits, which vary depending on use of hourly workers. The city modified Monona Terrace's budget request with an increase in the amount coming out of reserves, and they increased TOT funding. With this, they also increased Inter-departmental charges. 420 events currently on the books are a solid start to meeting the event revenue budget, and it is anticipated that over 100 events will be booked within the year to help close the gap.

3. Appointment of a new member to the Finance Committee

The committee thinks Judy Karofsky would be a good addition to the group and an invitation will be extened.
