2. 2025 Operating Budget

3. Budget Discussion

Revenue for 2025 is projected to be higher than 2024. Client spending has been trending higher than historical averages and Catering revenue is on the rise. 2025 is anticipated to have 21 conventions and 26 conferences, two less than 2024. Salary and wages expenses are up 11% due to wage and benefit increases. The Operating budget request as instructed by City Finance will remain the same as the 2024 budget request at \$5,392,000.
