Minutes –

Alder Heck made a motion to approve the last minutes August 18, 2022. Giesfeldt seconded the motion. There was unanimous consent.

Discussion on the draft budget report

Konkel shared the draft 2022 Police Budget Roadmap. Konkol and Alder Heck went through the document sharing areas that are missing or need to be updated. There are areas that may not be updated prior to the September 14 PSRC meeting and this would be noted. It was shared information from other budget subcommittee meetings are maintained on the PSRC agenda file in the budget subcommittee report. Konkol and Alder Heck indicated they would go through the document and finish areas where information could be added and send to PSRC committee members by September 9 for committee members to be able to look over. There was discussion on the creation of the press release, powerpoint, and questions that would be sent out prior to the September 14 meeting. Public comment would begin at 6pm. Konkol shared a press release that went out to the public the last time the PSRC held a public comment session on the police budget. On the press release there were 3 questions that were previously created and asked at that time during public comment. The subcommittee looked over the questions and discussed if these were questions that should be asked again. It was decided that new questions should be asked such as identifying top issues within the budget and other staff type of questions. Alder Heck and Moe shared they would work together to create three questions and the powerpoint for the upcoming public comment. Alder Heck intends to reach out to the Council Office to work with the Chief of Staff on creating the press release to be disseminated. It was decided the questions and the powerpoint should be sent to Chairs Giesfeldt and Milton prior to the PSRC meeting to see that they are added to the agenda.

Scheduling and next steps

The final budget roadmap will be shared with the committee prior to the September 14 PSRC meeting. The budget roadmap, press release, questions, and powerpoint will be posted on the PSRC agenda. There was no further meetings scheduled at this time
